

Colorado Blue Spruce: Great for landscapes, colors range from slightly blue-green to marvelous blue. Tolerate to a wide range of soil conditions, grows to an average height of 80 feet.



Shellbark Hickory: This is a high-branching tree with a straight, slender trunk and a narrow, oblong crown. It's a sturdy tree with shaggy bark. The nuts are large and sweet. The tree will bear nuts in 10-12 years & bears annually, although generally not heavily.



<u>Green Rocket Cedar:</u> White tail deer resistant with a pleasant cedar like aroma. It has soft foliage and can tolerate drought and most soil conditions. This hybrid can grow 3 feet a year reaching a width of 6 to 10 feet and 25 feet tall.



Ivory Silk Lilac: This is a tree form lilac with large plumes of small white flowers in early summer. Blooms after all other spring flowering trees have finished blooming. Ivory Silk Lilac grows slowly to 20 ft. tall and 15 ft. wide and will fit into smaller spaces.



Exclamation London Plane: Heat and drought tolerant tree that looks similar to a Sycamore. It can grow 5'-6'/year up to 60' tall with a 50' spread. It has patchy cream & tan bark with dark green leaves. Tolerates a wide range of soil conditions.



<u>Canada Red Chokecherry:</u> It is known for foliage that is a darker reddish purple with a thicker leaf texture. It can grow up to 20 feet tall and 15 foot wide.



Norway Spruce: A wonderful windbreak plant, this dense evergreen has short dark green, flat needles. Will grow in most Ohio soils except water soaked. Reaches an average height of 50-60 feet.




Princeton American Elm: Resistant to Dutch elm disease. This tree will thrive in almost any soil condition. Princeton Elm has a classic vase shape with beautiful yellow fall color. Princeton Elm will spread out in later years and will grow to 60 ft. tall and 40 ft. wide.



American Cranberry: This deciduous shrub can get up to 10-12 feet high and 8 feet wide. Preferring full sun or part shade it has showy white flowers followed by red berries in the fall and winter. Great for wildlife!



Autumn Blaze Maple: This extremely fast growing maple has strong branching and turns a brilliant red hue in the fall. Under good conditions it can grow 3 feet a year. It is tolerant of clay soils and drought. (Photo shown with fall colors)





Skyrise: These trees are hardy and disease resistant. Used for privacy screens, windbreaks, soil conservation, erosion control and landscaping. Skyrise will grow to 50' and 20' wide.

Native Tree Pack Options:

Swamp White Oak, American Hazelnut, Persimmon, American Plum, and Ninebark.

Hazelnut, Butternut, Northern Pecan, and Black Walnut.
